<p>Somewhat less than expected -1 <i>(Benchmark)</i></p>	<p>Goal 1: Each agency will provide 1 ASD Overview training and at least 2 agencies will collaborate to provide a minimum of 1 ASD Overview training for families.</p> <p>Goal 2: Districts provide 2 EBP trainings to 2-3 teachers/sites and provide coaching to 1 teacher/site. ACRC provides 1 EBP training for vendors and/or service coordinators and technical support for coaching for 1 vendor.</p> <p>Goal 3: CAPTAIN Cadre members will network and better define collaboration for the region during quarterly meetings. Local EBP “experts” will be identified.</p>
<p>Expected level of outcome 0 <i>(Annual Goal)</i></p>	<p>Goal 1: Capital CAPTAIN Conference will provide ASD Overview training for 50 families/providers.</p> <p>Goal 2: In addition to above, previously identified local EBP “experts” will provide specific EBP trainings for 50 families/providers at Capital CAPTAIN Conference.</p> <p>Goal 3: CAPTAIN Cadre members will develop a Dropbox account to share presentations and pictures.</p>
<p>Somewhat more than expected +1 <i>(Exceeds annual goal)</i></p>	<p>Goal 1: Capital CAPTAIN Conference will provide ASD Overview training for 100 families/providers.</p> <p>Goal 2: In addition to above, previously identified local EBP “experts” will provide specific EBP trainings for 100 families/providers at Capital CAPTAIN Conference.</p> <p>Goal 3: In addition to above, CAPTAIN Cadre members will host a Capital CAPTAIN booth at the Autism Speaks walk and make superhero capes. :)</p>
<p>Much more than expected +2 <i>(Far exceeds annual goal)</i></p>	<p>Goal 1: Capital CAPTAIN Conference will provide ASD Overview training for 150 with presentations specialized to audience members (breakouts, family specific, Spanish, etc)</p> <p>Goal 2: In addition to above, previously identified local EBP “experts” will provide specific EBP trainings for 150 families/providers with specialized audiences at Capital CAPTAIN Conference. Districts and ACRC will also provide EBP training and coaching to 5 sites/vendors</p> <p>Goal 3: In addition to above, CAPTAIN Cadre member will outline a process for teaming and joint decision making during transition planning.</p>
