<i>Current Regional Issue, Challenge or Problems of Practice</i>	People with Autism receive mental health and behavioral interventions at a lower rate than people without Autism
Probable Root Cause of the Problem (identify the top probable root cause)	Practitioners, educators and those who work with people with Autism are not informed about the complex mental health and behavioral needs of students with Autism, frequently believing that people with Autism can't benefit from mental health and behavioral interventions due to having Autism.
Change Ideas (list 1 change idea for the probable root cause)	Informing mental health and behavior specialists about the mental health and behavioral health needs of people with Autism would increase the amount of mental health and behavior interventions that 1. people with Autism receive.
