

## **REGIONAL Problem of Practice:** What issues, challenges or needs exist for individuals with Autism that our Regional Network wants to try to address?

Current Regional Issue, Challenge or Problems of Practice	Individuals with autism in San Diego and Imperial Counties have a variety of unmet needs (including access to high-quality services in areas such mental health, communication, and socialization), which impedes their access to equitable opportunities and meaningful community participation.
Probable Root Cause of the Problem (identify the top probable root cause)	Across school and community environments, there is a general ableist mindset as well as a lack of understanding of neurodiversity and how to create welcoming, inclusive environments. People within the system of support (family members, school personnel, mental health providers) may be misinformed or have limited knowledge and skills within their scope of practice to provide support to autistic individuals across domains. Families may be unaware of how to overcome roadblocks to access services. Supports that do exist may not be high-quality or evidence-based and are often provided "in silos" rather than a collaborative effort. Additionally, there may be limited resources, especially in remote areas.
Change Ideas (list 1 change idea for the probable root cause)	If people within the system of support (family, school, community) have:  a better understanding of neurodiversity and ableism  skills in creating welcoming, inclusive environments  increased knowledge and skills to access support or provide support (depending on their role)  opportunities to provide support in a collaborative way  Then autistic individuals may experience:  fewer unmet needs  greater access to opportunities and community participation
