<b>Goal Area 1 (Collaboration):</b> How can the cadre collaborate to address the region’s specific need, issue or challenge that relates to autistic individuals and their families. <b>2024/2025</b>	
<i>Current Level of Performance Data (0)</i>	<p>November 2024</p> <p><b>The</b> East Bay Cadre currently has 3 EBP Newsletters available in the East Bay’s Shared Drive that can be utilized across all cadre agency partners: FSAs, RCs, SELPAs and school districts; currently they are all in English only and cannot effectively support our EL families.</p> <p><b>The</b> current logo/emblem of the CofEB was established in 2013/14 of its inaugural year; a few members have regional shirts.</p>
<i>Initial Objective (1)</i>	<p>November 2024</p> <p><b>Identify</b> how many of the current Newsletters will be targeted for translation (1=VS) and which languages the current Newsletters will be translated into (Spanish &amp; Chinese).</p> <p><b>Establish</b> two small identified regional groups within the larger EB region to create 2 additional Newsletters for the CAPTAIN year for all agency stakeholder dissemination.</p> <p><b>Establish</b> another small identified regional group within the larger EB region to design and create a new regional emblem.</p>
<i>Secondary Objective (2)</i>	<p>January 2025</p> <p><b>Establish</b> which of the cadre are taking ownership to translate the VS Newsletter (Monica &amp; Betty).</p> <p><b>Established</b> Newsletter cohorts will have selected the specific EBPs to be the content of focus for the new Newsletters (SS, EXC).</p> <p><b>Emblem</b> team will set a meeting time to come to the meeting with ideas to discuss.</p>
<i>Expected level of Outcome (3)</i>	<p>September 2025</p> <p><b>The</b> emblem team will present the cadre with the finalized logo with instruction on how to order the decided upon wearable item(s) for personal and Summit wear.</p> <p>October 2025</p> <p><b>East Bay</b> Cadre will have a minimum of 5 EBP newsletters located in the East Bay Shared Drive, 2 of which are new and 1 previous Newsletter (VS) which has been translated into 2 different languages. All Newsletters will serve the intent of collaboratively being utilized across all agency partners for dissemination to their various stakeholders.</p>
<i>Exceeds Expected Outcome (4)</i>	<p>October-November 2025</p> <p><b>The</b> previous VS Newsletter is translated into a 3rd language: Tagalog or Arabic.</p>

<b>Goal Area 2 (Dissemination):</b> How can members of our regional network strategically disseminate to groups identified by the region as needing to know about autism and EBPs/CAPTAIN. <b>2024/2025</b>	
<i>Current Level of Performance Data (0)</i>	<p>November 2024 - <b>The</b> East Bay Cadre has collaborated on and designed 3 EBP Newsletters available in the East Bay's Shared Drive, and they've been disseminated by and across all cadre agency partners: FSAs, RCs, SELPAs and school districts to reach a wide array of stakeholders. The Newsletters however are currently only available in English and cannot effectively support our EL families.</p> <p><b>Additionally</b>, there was no immediate plan after the 3rd Newsletter to create another.</p>
<i>Initial Objective (1)</i>	<p>January 2025 - <b>All</b> timelines of objectives will be reviewed and agreed upon by the EB cadre.</p> <p><b>Small</b> cohorts and decided upon EBP's will also be finalized.</p>
<i>Secondary Objective (2)</i>	<p>March 2025 - <b>The</b> 4th EBP Newsletter will be presented to the East Bay Cadre by the assigned small cohort with the intention for Regional Cadre members to then share the information with their various agency stakeholders prior to the May 2025 Regional Meeting.</p> <p><i>*Cadre will be given approximately 3 days to generate any feedback to the cohort for possible edits/changes before the Newsletter is finalized. The cohort will have approximately one week to finalize the Newsletter and alert the whole Cadre when the Newsletter has been Shared to the Drive.</i></p>
<i>Expected level of Outcome (3)</i>	<p>May 2025 - <b>The</b> 5th EBP Newsletter will be presented to the EB Cadre by the assigned small cohort, and;</p> <p><b>The</b> 4th EBP Newsletter will have been shared with a minimum of 5 people within their agency purview by all attendees at the January 2025 Regional Cadre Meeting.</p> <p>March-May 2025</p> <p><b>The</b> VS Newsletter will be presented to the EB cadre in the 2 varying languages (Chinese &amp; Spanish).</p> <p>September 2025</p> <p><b>The</b> two new created Newsletters will have been shared with a minimum of 5 people each within their agency purview by all attendees at the May 2025 Regional Cadre Meeting.</p> <p><b>The</b> translated VS Newsletter will have additionally been shared with a minimum of 5 people each, in at least 1/2 languages within their agency purview by all attendees.</p> <p><b>At</b> least 5 EBP Newsletters, with VS specifically available in 2 languages, will now be available to all East Bay Regional Cadre in the East Bay Shared Drive to disseminate to various stakeholder groups at any time.</p>
<i>Exceeds Expected Outcome (4)</i>	<p>October 2025 - <b>Each</b> participating EB Cadre member at the October Regional CAPTAIN 2024/25 Closeout Meeting will have disseminated the 2 new available Newsletters to approximately 10 people each within their agency purview as well as disseminated the translated Newsletter to approximately 10 people each - Chinese &amp; Spanish.</p>
