CAPTAIN is a multiagency network developed to support the understanding and use of Evidence Based Practices (EBPs) for individuals affected by Autism across the state to improve academic, social and vocational outcomes.

VISION

Establish a statewide training and technical assistance network focused on the use of EBPs for autism inclusive of agencies who will work collaboratively at a local level so individuals on the autism spectrum and their families can benefit from research-based practices.

MISSION

Increase knowledge about autism and EBPs through systematic dissemination of information.

Increase implementation of EBPs with fidelity in schools and community settings (families and providers of services).

Increase interagency collaborations to leverage resources, solve local challenges and standardize use of EBPs across the state.

Create an equipped workforce by collaborating with higher education, preparation programs and early career mentoring programs.

Leadership Team:

The Leadership Team is comprised of professionals from the California Department of Education, SELPAs, University Centers for Excellence in Developmental Disabilities (UCEDDs), Family Resource Centers Network of CA, Regional Centers, Universities, Department of Developmental Services, and Diagnostic Centers. Our leadership participated as trainers in the National Professional Development Center for Autism statewide training project. As a part of the dissemination efforts of the NPDC-Autism, we have established CAPTAIN to support implementation of EBPs across our state to improve outcomes for individuals with autism.

CAPTAIN Cadre Members:

Cadre members are nominated by SELPAs, Regional Centers, and Family Resource Centers Network of CA. They receive training through our annual statewide Summit so that they can provide local training, implementation coaching, cross agency collaboration, and dissemination of the EBPs for autism at the local level. Cadre members have access to the NPDC-Autism and CAPTAIN training materials and assist with the statewide distribution of the EBPs by providing support and training locally.
