*Goal Area 1 (Collaboration):* How can the cadre collaborate to address the region's specific need, issue or challenge that relates to autistic individuals and their families 2023/24

Current Level of Performance Data (0)	October 2023 The East Bay Cadre currently has no source of established relevant/similar EBP content information available that can be utilized across all agency partners: FSAs, RCEB, SELPAs and school districts.
Initial Objective (1)	October 2023 Establish three small identified regional groups within the larger East Bay Cadre to create quarterly a visual support (Newsletter) for all agency stakeholder dissemination.
Secondary Objective (2)	November 2023/January 2024 Established cohorts will have selected the specific EBP to be the content of focus for the Newsletter, and the format for the VS will have been determined by the Regional Cadre.
<b>Expected level of Outcome</b> (3)	May 2024 East Bay Cadre will have a minimum of 3 EBP Newsletters located in the East Bay Shared Drive that can collaboratively be utilized across all agency partners for dissemination to their various stakeholders.
Exceeds Expected Outcome (4)	September 2024 to October/November 2024 A 4th EBP Newsletter will be created and added to the Shared Drive following the same format prior to the Annual 2024 Summit for East Bay agencies/stakeholder dissemination.

Current Level of Performance Data (0)	October 2023 The East Bay Cadre currently has no source of established relevant/similar EBP content information available that can be utilized across all agency partners: FSAs, RCEB, SELPAs and school districts to disseminate to various stakeholders across the region.
Initial Objective (1)	January 2024 The 1st EBP Newsletter will be presented to the East Bay Cadre by the assigned small cohort with the intention for Regional Cadre members to then share the information with their various agency stakeholders prior to the March 2024 Regional Meeting.
Secondary Objective (2)	March 2024 The 2nd EBP Newsletter will be presented to the East Bay Cadre by the assigned small cohort, and the 1st EBP Newsletter will have been shared with a minimum of 5 people within their agency purview by all attendees at the January 2024 Regional Cadre Meeting.
<b>Expected level of Outcome</b> (3)	May 2024 -The 3rd EBP Newsletter will be presented to the East Bay Cadre by the assigned small cohort, and the 1st two created Newsletters will have been shared with a minimum of 5 people each within their agency purview by all attendees at the March 2024 Regional Cadre Meeting. -At least 3 Newsletter type visual supports <b>will now be available</b> to all East Bay Regional Cadre in the East Bay Shared Drive to disseminate to
